



Financial Counseling Program-2008

- *Are you struggling with having enough money to pay your bills?*

- *Have you recently lost your job and are struggling to make ends meet?*

If you said yes to any of the above questions then, this program is designed for you. You are not alone. This program consists of one 2-hour session. The first hour will be done in group format where we will discuss the basics of why we need to budget, the parts of a spending plan and why goals are important. The second hour you will be partnered one-on-one with a trained volunteer who will go over your individual situation with you and help you start to build a spending or money management plan. You will leave with a beginning spending plan and goals to work on. If you choose to come back again you can sign up for just the second hour of the one-on-one counseling if you wish.
